On-site caregivers cannot provide the level of 24/7 supervision that modern remote monitoring systems can deliver. Technology enables needed supervision in a much less intrusive manner than on-site paid staff, and gives people the opportunity to live on their own and increases opportunities for independence and quality of life.

Remote monitoring systems like [Sengistix](#) provide safety and wellness monitoring with unobtrusive sensors that do not rely on cameras or audio intrusions. Today's technology verifies that individuals are safe at home and accomplishing the activities required to remain safe and well. In addition, the system can deliver helpful reminder prompts remotely.

This session will introduce the Sengistix technology and give participants an opportunity to tour an apartment that utilizes the technology. The Thursday session is for parents or guardians and the Friday session is for professionals.
